



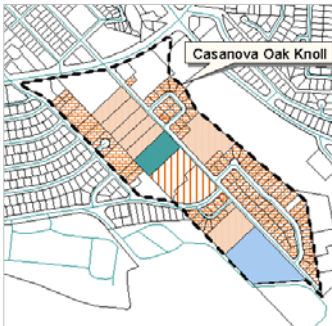

## Monterey Peninsula Airport Residential Sound Insulation Program

### Summary of Scope of Work:

Jones Payne serves as the Program Consultant for the Monterey Peninsula Airport District's Residential Soundproofing Program. Approximately 474 properties in the Casanova Oak Knoll, Del Monte Beach, and Villa Del Monte neighborhoods were deemed eligible to receive acoustical treatments based upon acoustical testing and a detailed architectural/ engineering evaluation.

As the Program Manager, Architect, and Construction Administrators, Jones Payne implemented a number of program innovations to better inform the general public and eligible homeowners, and provide clear program guidelines for the anticipated development, including:

- **Program Policy and Procedures Manual** – guidelines for program eligibility, acoustical criteria, treatment applications, and overall design & construction process.
- **“Sound Update” Newsletter** – a quarterly newsletter that educates homeowners about the program, the soundproofing process, and upcoming events.
- **Product Display Center & Program Office** – Full-time community-based program office and drop-in center for program participants to view actual installations of acoustical products and meet with Program staff.
- **Geographical Information System** – neighborhood and individual parcel mapping of homes within the CNEL noise contours and program area that is linked to the program database.
- **Program Database** – a database for the tracking and recording of previously treated homes, as well as current phases and all other eligible homeowners.
