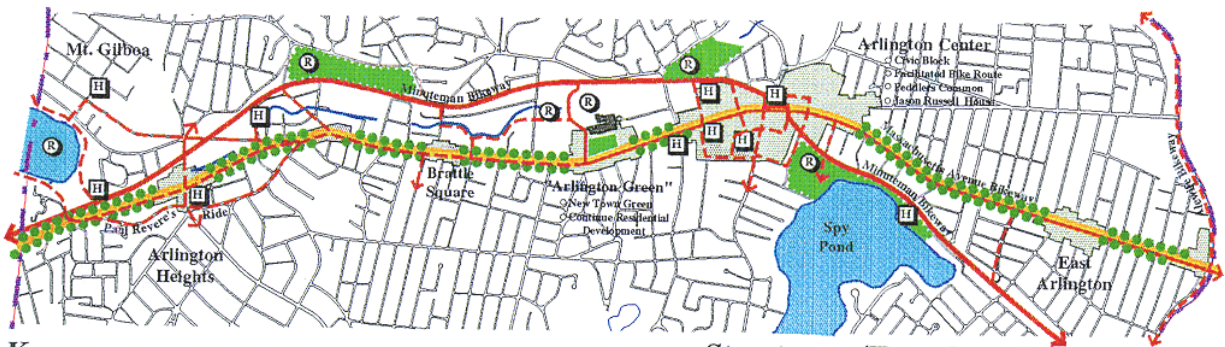

The ABC study is an award winning comprehensive planning, transportation and economic revitalization strategy that included urban design and streetscape improvements, identification of key development sites and the development of a “heritage” concept for Arlington’s main business corridor. Randolph Jones served as the principal Urban Designer for a multi-disciplinary team, whose goal was to create an Urban Design Plan for the Town of Arlington’s spine, the 2.5-mile length of Massachusetts Avenue. The plan addressed landscape, urban design, transportation and economic development issues with the objectives of improving the physical image, traffic and parking functions, pedestrian and bicycle access and the economic vitality of Arlington’s various commercial districts situated along Massachusetts Avenue.
