Broadway and Andrew Transit Station Modernization

The Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) implemented a three-phase station modernization program on the Redline to upgrade and increase the capacity of individual stations to accommodate six car train operations. Key modernization objectives were to improve passenger comfort, station operations, safety and maintenance. The Jones Payne Group, in association with Vollmer Associates, completed the analysis of existing station conditions and the schematic design phase for the modernization of the Broadway and Andrew stations on the MBTA Red Line. The Broadway Station was completely reorganized with new station entrances on West Broadway and Dorchester Avenue in South Boston. The at grade central bus shelter was replaced, and new escalators and elevators for handicapped access were installed. A revised fare collection area with a 2-level space overlooking the extended platform area provided improved passenger surveillance from the mezzanine lobby.
