Logan International Airport Logan Growth and Impact Control Study (L.O.G.I.C.)

Boston, MA

Summary of scope of work:

The Logan Growth and Impact Control (LOGIC) Study was undertaken by the Massachusetts Port Authority (Massport) to plan for the growth of Logan International Airport through a 20 year time horizon. The primary objective of the master planning effort was to identify strategies and actions to accommodate potentially significant growth in the airside and landside activities at Logan while maintaining current levels of environmental impacts. Jones Payne served as the Land Use Consultant on the Master Planning Team, and was responsible for analyzing on-airport support functions including air cargo facilities, passenger / employee parking, and rental car operations. Jones Payne also developed an overall neighborhood noise mitigation strategy, and prepared an Airport Edge Strategy based upon projected future on-airport facilities adjacent to the surrounding housing and community facilities.
